

**ACTIVITY OF THE RADIOLOGICAL MONITORING AND DATA
ACQUISITION NETWORK (RAMDAN)
OF THE HUNGARIAN HEALTH SECTOR BETWEEN 2010-2015**

RAMDAN was established in 1975 by an internal order of the Minister of Health. Its primary goal is the regular, routine, radiological monitoring of the environment, including a qualitative and quantitative analysis of artificial radionuclides, in order to estimate the risk and degree of the health damage to the public.

The presentation will present the structure of the Network, its collaborators, the sampling and measuring programme and presents the measuring results of the past five years. The monitoring subprograms run by the Network and the National Research Directorate are also presented and main professional events are listed.

The National Research Directorate plays a central role in the operation of RAMDAN, as it gives professional guidance to the RAMDAN, plans the annual sampling and measuring programme of RAMDAN and so on. The RAMDAN Information Centre (RAMDAN IC), which collects and processes the data obtained is also operated by the National Research Directorate.
